Ebook readers

- **Amazon Kindle**, Not a good look & feel need to purchase content via Amazon Little take up so test abandoned
- **Sony PRS-505** touchscreen and stylus, collections – something like a playlist or folder ;five font sizes and side lights for reading in the dark or low light settings. It is also possible to create a bookmark.
 - 8 fiction titles. Proved to be the most popular Always checked out
- **iRex iLiad** 15 font gradations, noticeably clearer text on a larger 8 inch screen, Multiple online book vendors. In addition to loading free or purchased monographic titles, many other document formats are supported, including .pdf, .doc, .html, .txt and others. Technical books loaded onto flash drives.
- **iPod Touch and an HTC Dual Touch smartphone were also tested. Also useful devices**
- **Verdict Sony good for general reading. iRex iLiad good for technical works but complicated to set up.**

IATUL Conference - Mel Collier

Innovation – From biomedical library to e-only learning centre supported by a co-operative depot service

- Building development - space taken from library
 - smaller, more intensive reader area
 - based on Warwick Learning Grid
- Not a central store – collaborative approach – one copy print
- Not for humanities
- Holdings checked against Flemish union catalogue Antilope
- Depot holder - may not dispose without consulting other partners
 - identified on Antilope
 - keep in reasonable conditions
 - deliver with 48 hours at standard price
- Next
 - to natural/exact sciences
 - extend to Walloons
- Disposal
 - are they capital items? Board agreed to disposal

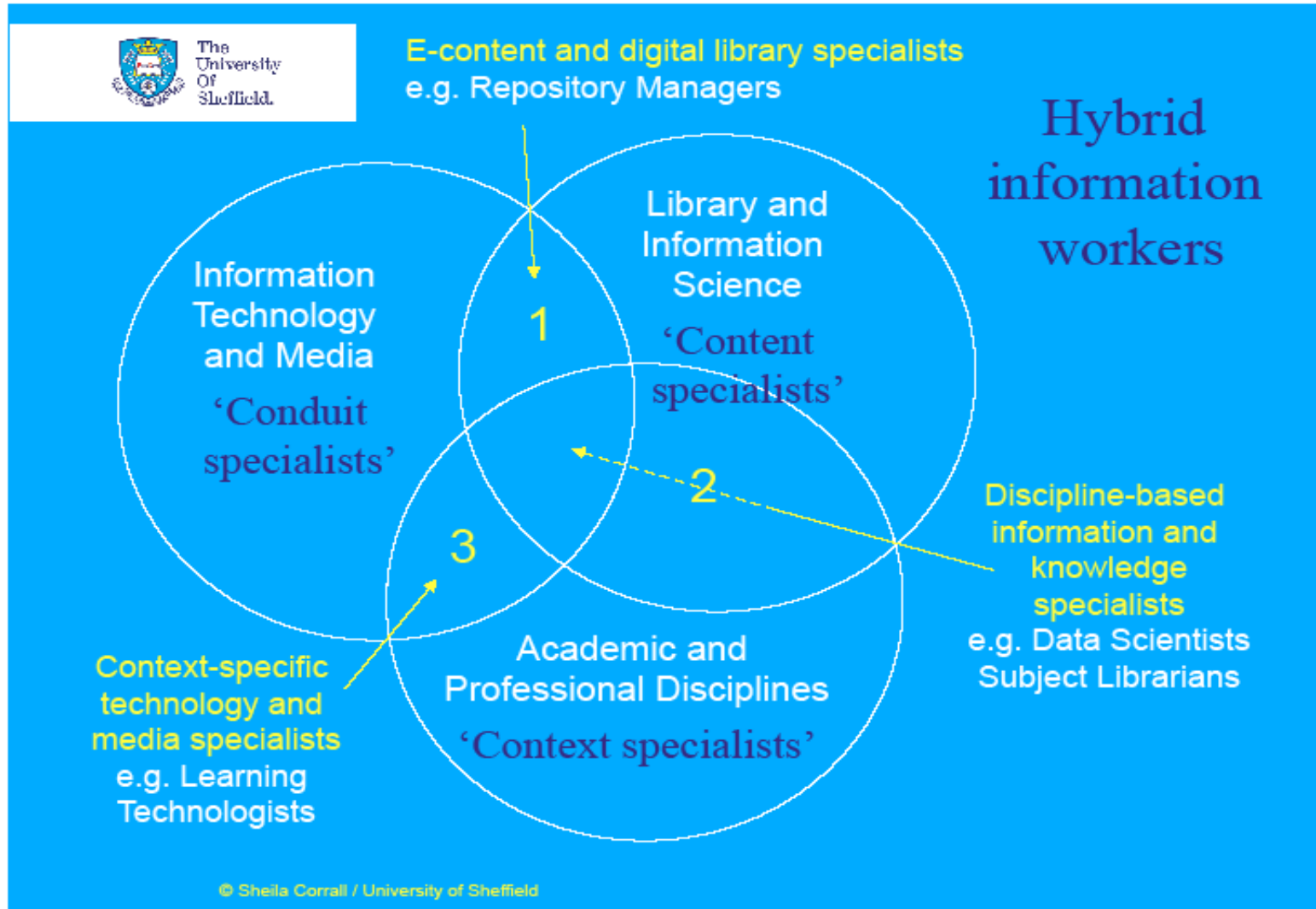

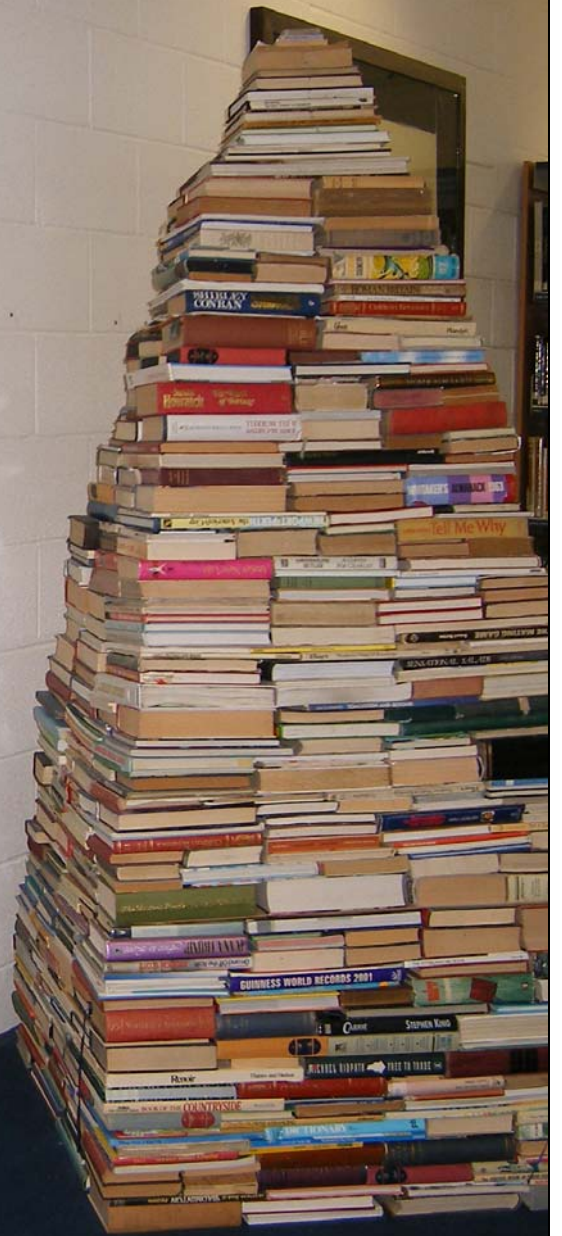
