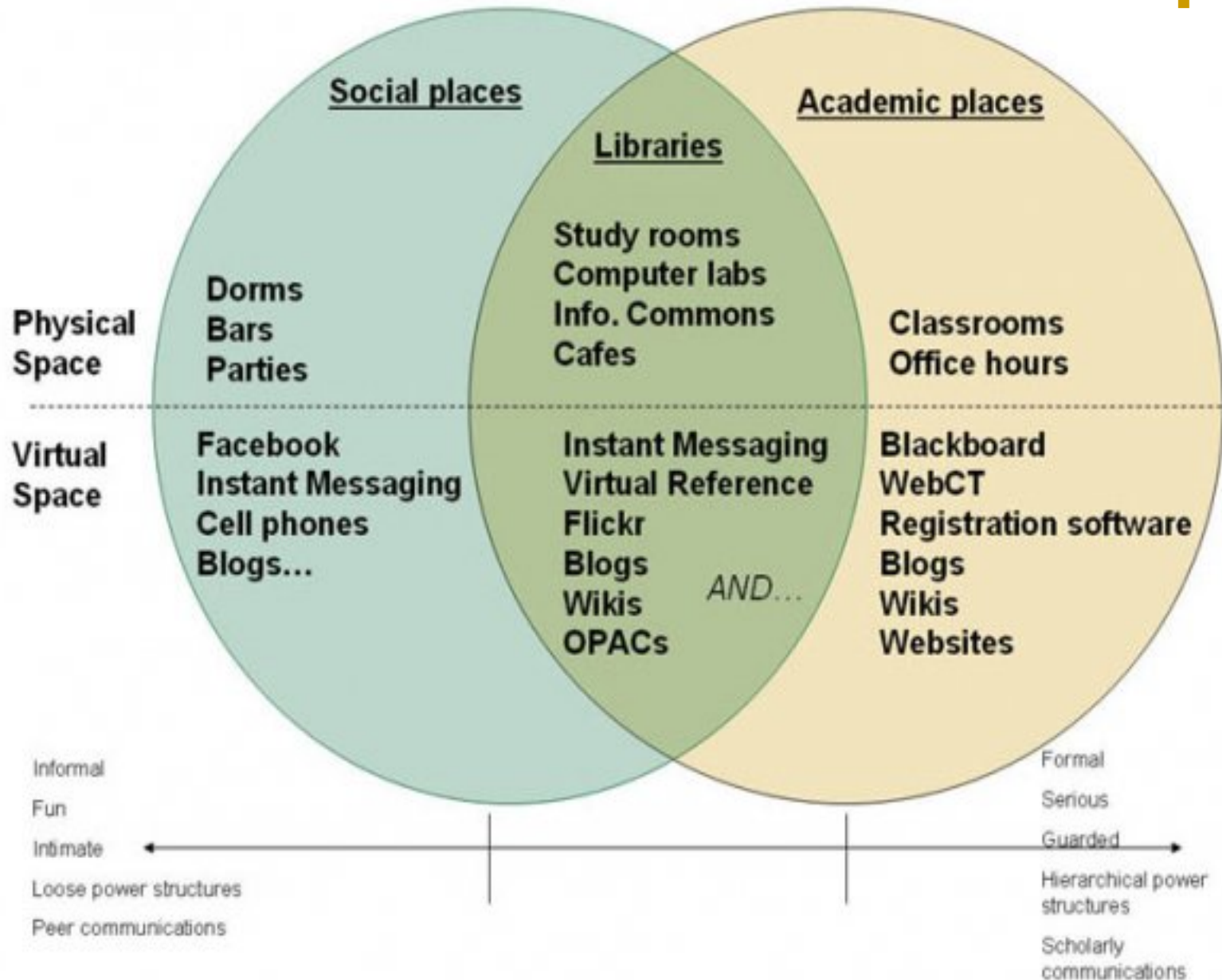

Death and the Maiden Quartet (Schubert)

The String Quartet in D minor written in 1824 by Franz Schubert, just after the composer became aware of his ruined health, is popularly known as the **Death and the Maiden Quartet** from the variation-subject of the second movement. In the numerical order of his quartets it is his String Quartet No. 14, and is D. 810 in Otto Erich Deutsch's thematic catalog of Schubert's works. The work is a string quartet in four movements:

1. Allegro, in D minor and common time
2. Andante con moto, in G minor and divided common (2:2) time
3. Scherzo: Allegro molto, in D minor and 3:4 time
4. Presto, in D minor in 6:8

The opening movement is, along with that of the preceding and next quartet and that of his string quintet, among the most extended and substantial in his chamber music output, if not in his output as a whole. It is a sonata form movement whose exposition encompasses three main key regions, D minor, F major and A minor.

The second movement is a theme — taken from his macabre song *Der Tod und Das Mädchen* (D 531 in Deutsch's catalog) — and five variations, with coda.

The third movement's main theme can also be heard in one of a set of piano dances; its lyrical D major trio varies its 'repeats'.

The relentless finale-tarantella is a sonata-rondo in form — a rondo whose first episode returns as the last, and whose central section contains elements of development. Its coda promises major-mode triumph, and snatches it away.

Arrangements

In 1878, Robert Franz transcribed the quartet for piano duet.

This is one of the quartet works, along with Beethoven's String Quartet No. 11 in F minor ("*Quartetto serioso*"), that Mahler arranged for use by a string orchestra, mostly by doubling some of the cello parts with double basses.

In 1930 the British composer John Foulds made a version "as a symphony" for full (classical) orchestra.

Appearances in film and television

Ariel Dorfman's 1991 play *Death and the Maiden* and its 1994 film adaptation (directed by Roman Polanski) take their names from the quartet.

Additionally, Schubert's quartet has been used in the score of at least the following:

- The 1996 Jane Campion film *The Portrait of a Lady*.
- The BBC TV production of *Sherlock Holmes and the Case of the Silk Stocking*

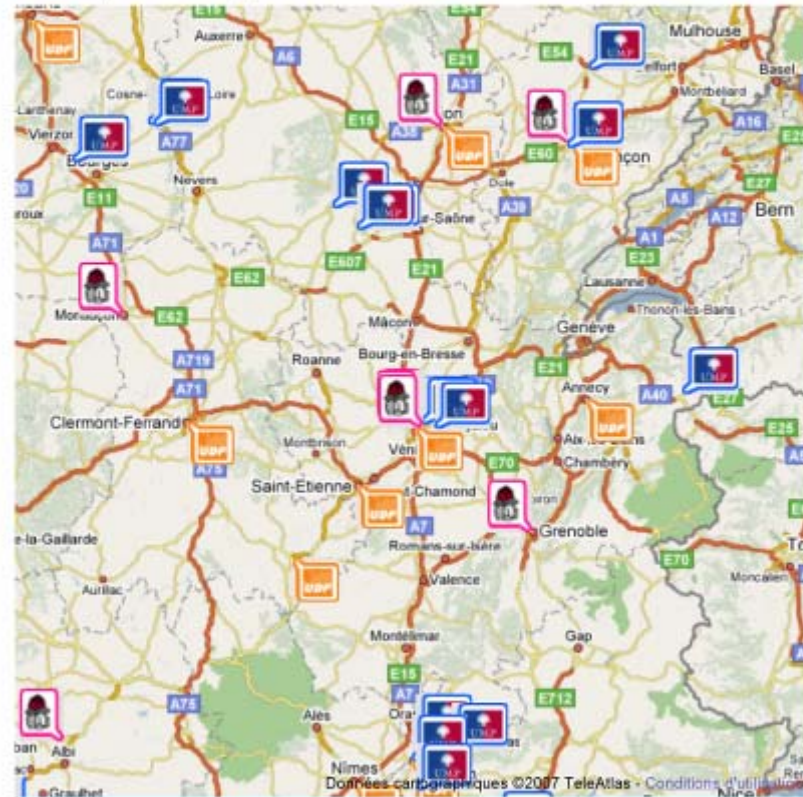

Changing Client Expectations: the Net Gen

- Ability to read visual images
 - intuitive visual communicators
 - Visual-spatial skills
 - can integrate the virtual and physical
 - Inductive discovery
 - learn better through discovery than by being told
 - Attentional deployment
 - able to shift attention rapidly from one task to another, and may choose not to pay attention to things that don't interest
 - Fast response time
 - able to respond quickly and expect rapid responses in return

Changing Client Expectations: the Net Gen

- “Prolific communicators, they [Net Gen] gravitate toward activities that promote and reinforce social interaction—whether IMing old friends, teaming up in an Internet game, posting Web diaries (blogging), or forwarding joke e-mails.”
 - display a striking openness to diversity, differences, and sharing
 - at ease meeting strangers on the Net
 - inclusiveness that does not necessarily involve personally knowing someone admitted to the group
 - seek to interact with others, sometimes through an alternative identity different from their own

Meeting the long-tail demand through Library 2.0

- ***The Long Tail*** consists of the interests of the minority that lie at the “tail” end of a power law, or statistical distribution
 - When combined, these non-mainstream, or niche interests far outnumber the popular ones.
 - Between 25 and 40% of Amazon’s sales come from the long tail and similarly one fifth of all Netflix rentals are from titles other than their top 3,000

LATN Web 2.0 Survey

- Survey of Curtin, QUT, RMIT, UniSA, UTS and AUT.
- Some use of university provided **wiki** services including functionality in learning management systems (eg Blackboard). Some consideration of externally provided services.
- Limited use of **blogging** for internal communication within some of the libraries. One using a blog to drive public 'news & events' service.
- Most providing some **RSS feeds** primarily of a 'news' nature.

LATN Web 2.0 Survey

- Some are using **podcasts** to deliver information or services.
- Some consideration of **tagging**.
- Some investigation of **platforms** such as Encore and Primo.

LATN Web 2.0 Survey

- Use of blogs and wikis to share information and promote collaboration internally especially for projects, part time staff, information literacy and staff development.
- One is using Microsoft Sharepoint to share documents.
- Some of the services are open to other parts of the University.
- Some interaction with students.
- No specific guidelines and policies for use of Web 2.0 services have been adopted. Reliance on university web and IT usage policies.

LATN Web 2.0 Survey

- All are maintaining a watching brief and encouraging enthusiasts.
- Information and support on Web 2.0:
 - A range of activities for library staff including presentations, discussions, sharing information via blogs/wikis/intranets, one which has conducted a '23 Things' style course. Beginning to form working groups. Information sessions for students and university staff.
- Communities of practice not formally established within the libraries but beginning to emerge in some.

LATN Collaborative Platform

- LATN has agreed to transform its website into a collaborative platform to support experiential learning of Library 2.0 concepts and tools.
- It will be organised around communities of practice in LATN priority areas to foster information sharing and collaborative activities.
