Living interstate from the university you are studying with and would like to borrow from a university library nearby?

or

Travelling interstate and would like to borrow from a local university library?

University Library Australia enables you to do just that!

University Library Australia is a national borrowing scheme that allows all staff and students of AVCC member universities to borrow in person from any other interstate university in Australia. The scheme is a cooperative arrangement between member universities of the Australian Vice Chancellors' Committee.

Regional borrowing schemes exist for borrowing from other universities in your state. Check the web site of local universities in your state for more information about these schemes.

WHO MAY *borrow?*

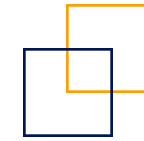
All students and staff from AVCC member universities are eligible to register with any university library that participates in the scheme. You can only borrow in person at the libraries with which you register. Membership is personal and not transferable.

Where CAN I BORROW?

You may borrow from any AVCC member university outside your regional borrowing scheme. See over for a complete list of participating university libraries.

How DO I APPLY?

You need to apply directly to the library you wish to borrow from. There is no need to contact your own university library. Applications are made in person unless the library has an online registration scheme. Check the National Borrowing Scheme web page of the library you wish to join for any details about registration and borrowing conditions.



What DOCUMENTS DO I NEED?

Students will be asked to present a photo ID as well as proof of current enrolment. This could be your enrolment advice form or other proof from your university.

Staff members will be asked to present a photo ID and proof of current employment with a university participating in the scheme. Where applicants are not currently employed at an Australian university, for example, a visiting scholar, proof of affiliation with an AVCC university that specifies arrangements for indemnity for borrowing must be provided.

The library you visit will either register you on the spot or mail your borrowing card to you in a few days.

IS REGISTRATION *permanent?*

No. Membership is for the current calendar year only, no matter when you join throughout the year. Borrowing privileges will expire on 28th February of the following year.

Proof of continued enrolment or employment will be required to renew your registration each year.

WHAT DOES REGISTRATION ENTITLE ME TO?

Membership privileges, such as what and how many items you can borrow, length of loans, access to electronic services and the internet, are at the discretion of the library at which you register. Make sure you pick up a brochure on their membership privileges.

Requests for inter-library loans and document delivery are not part of this scheme and should be made to the library of the university at which you study or work.

RETURNING MATERIAL

You must return material to the library from which you borrowed them. Penalties and fines for late return of material are at the discretion of the lending library. These will be set out in the membership brochure available at the lending library.

The lending library may also send details of overdue material or monies to your university library, which may also impose penalties.

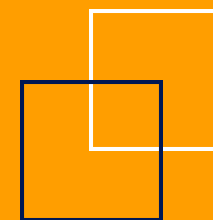
