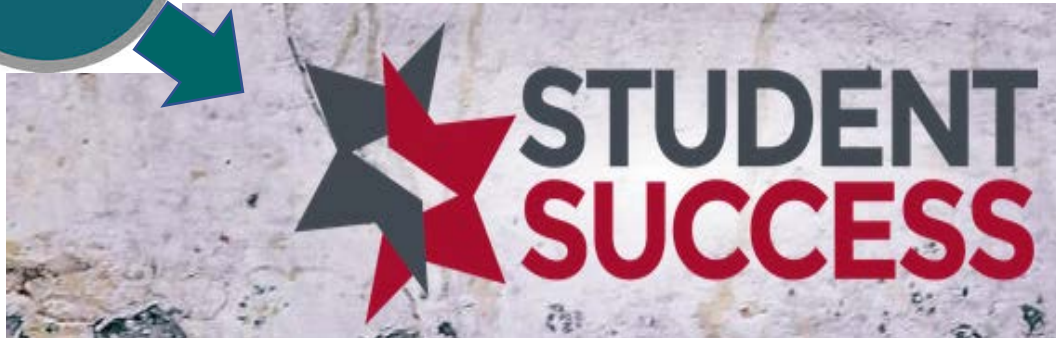

QUT eJournal Hosting Service

Summary

- Started by Liobrary in 2009 using locally hosted OJS software
- Driver was the need to find a solution for a journal (JLD) which was running on QUT's online teaching platform that was about to be replaced.
- Identified some existing journals running on the QUT website and invited them to bring their journal onboard.
- Subsequently approached by academics who wanted to launch new journals.

QUT eJournal Hosting Service

- MOU created to articulate expectations and responsibilities.
- No charge-back (currently) for technical/advisory support.
- The relevant Faculty needs to be willing to provide in-kind support in form of a 'journal manager'.
- Articles must be published under a CC Licence.
- IT Services manage/fund domain registration and security certificates.
- Library pays for Crossref (DOIs).
- Library provides advice on issues related to publishing (ISSN, copyright, indexing, directories etc).

QUT eJournal Hosting Service

Sustainability and Future planning

- Investigating options/costs for outsourcing technical support to a service provider.
- Investigating synergies with projects looking at OER & Open Monograph publishing
