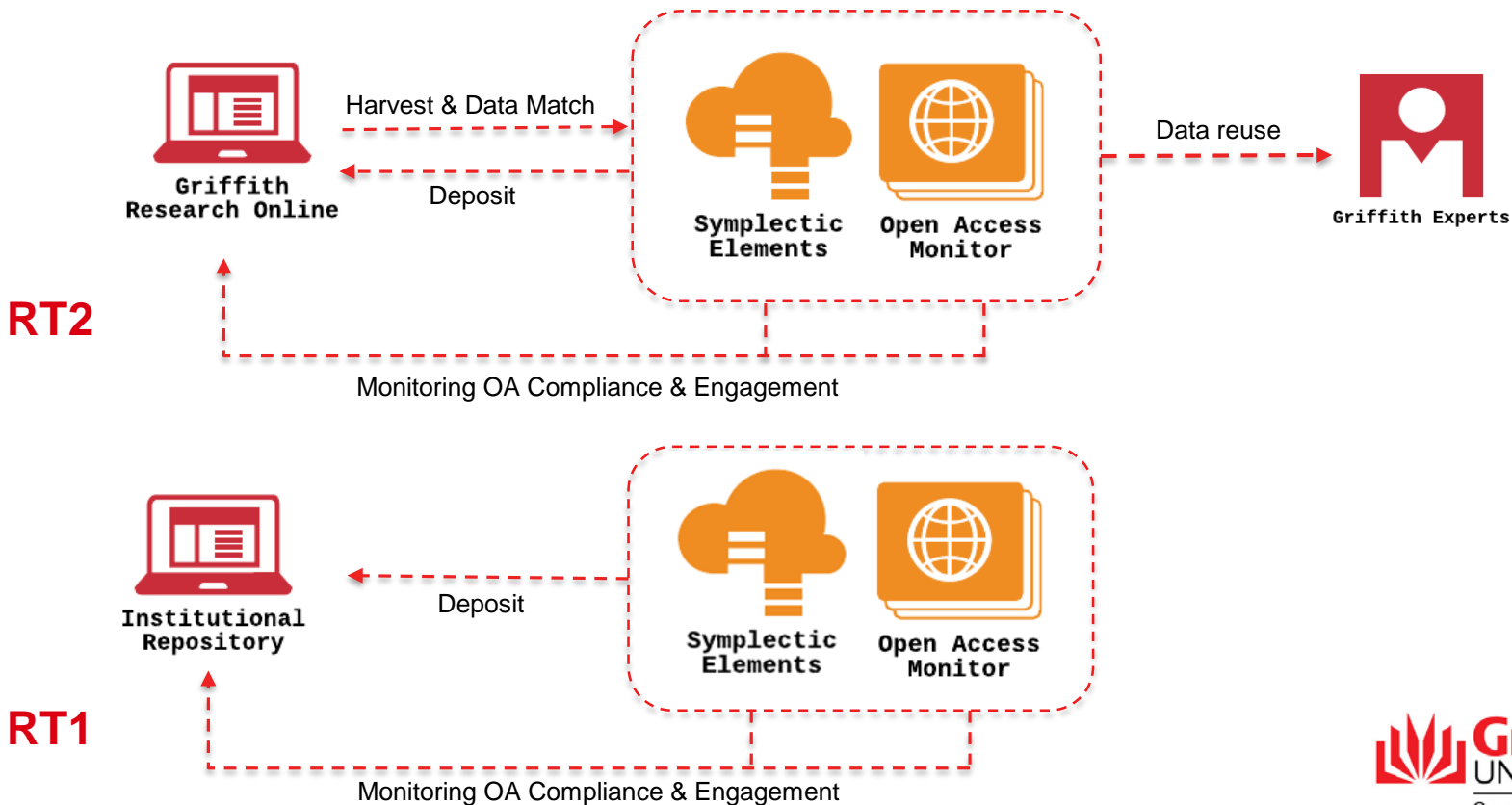

- Configuration
 - Crosswalks and ownership
- Repository as data source
 - Matching algorithm and data reuse

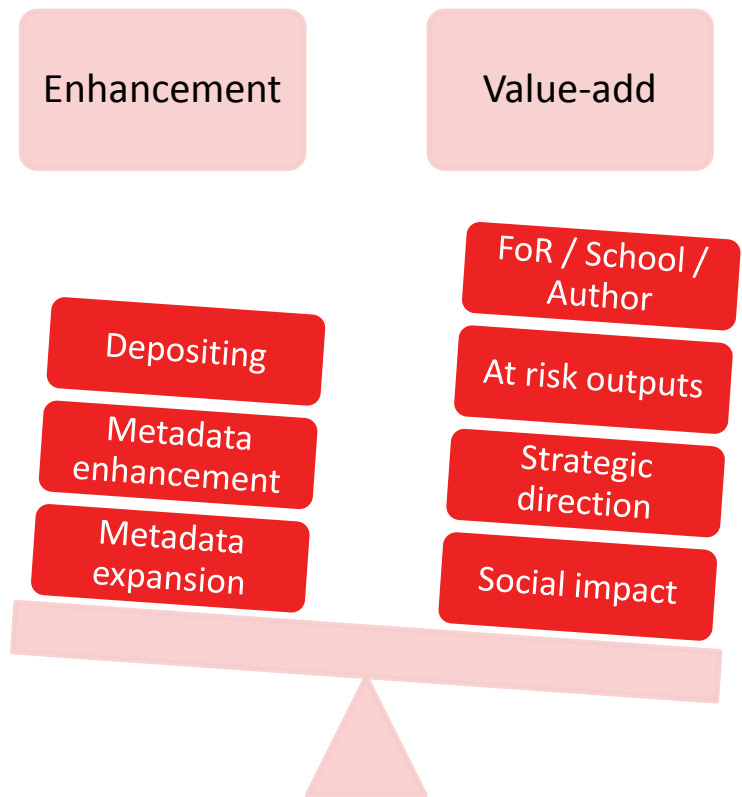
Future challenges – Roles and responsibilities
