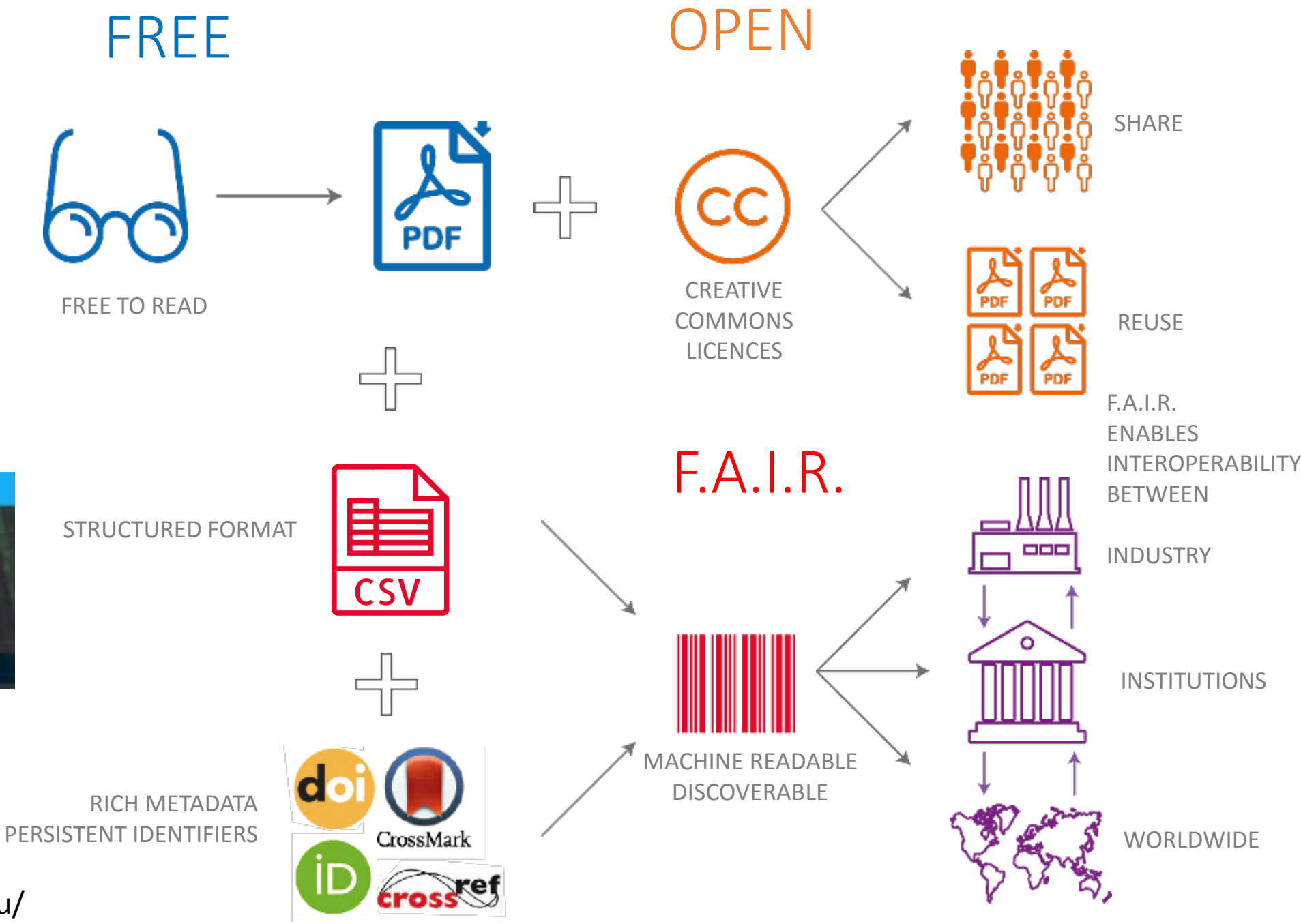

F

➤ FINDABLE

associated with rich metadata (e.g. identifiers, DOIs)

A

➤ ACCESSIBLE

available in a public repository or open journal site

I

➤ INTEROPERABLE

in a format that allows it to be exchanged and integrated

R

➤ REUSABLE

has a licence that allows reuse

The nuts and bolts of (open and) F.A.I.R.

PERMANENTLY IDENTIFIED OBJECTS 

LINKED TO THE RESEARCHERS 

IN OPEN SITES    - etc

IN HUMAN AND MACHINE READABLE FORMATS  

LINKED TO RELATED OBJECTS  

WITH CLEAR REUSE RIGHTS

Findable

- Does the research article have a DOI?
- Is the DOI on all versions of the research article, eg PDF, HTML?
- Are the research article's citations included in the O4IC initiative?

Accessible

- Where is the research article available?
- Is the metadata for the research article available even if the full text is not?

Interoperable

- What format is the full text of the research article available in?
- What unique identifiers are included in the metadata?

Reusable

- What are the license/usage rights attached to the research article?
- Who retains copyright?
