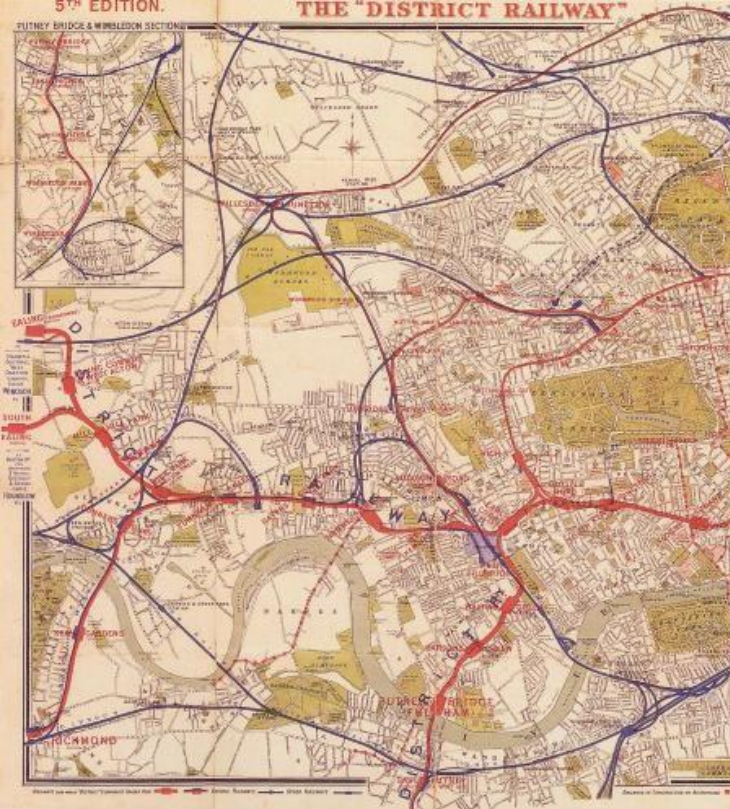
Cognitive load

Cognitive load : humans have a limited mental capacity in terms of working memory (Bolkan 2016).

Intrinsic vs. Extraneous

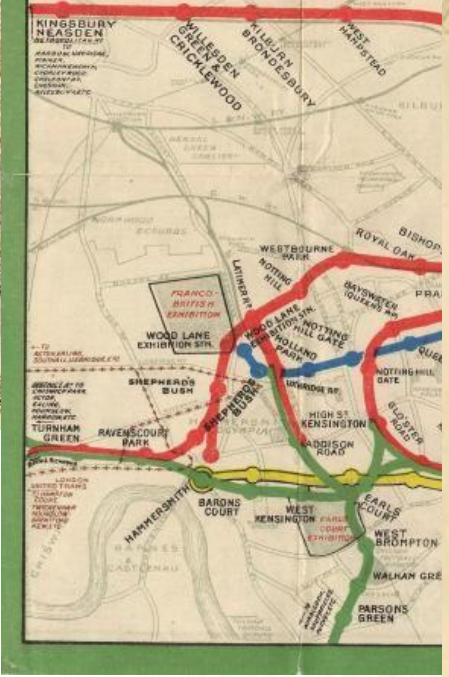
Good design helps to minimise extraneous cognitive load for users.

What is learning design?

“Simply a process for helping you to create effective training in an efficient manner. It is a system...that help(s) you ask the right questions, make the right decisions, and produce a product that is as useful and useable as your situation requires and allows.”

- (Piskurich, 2015)



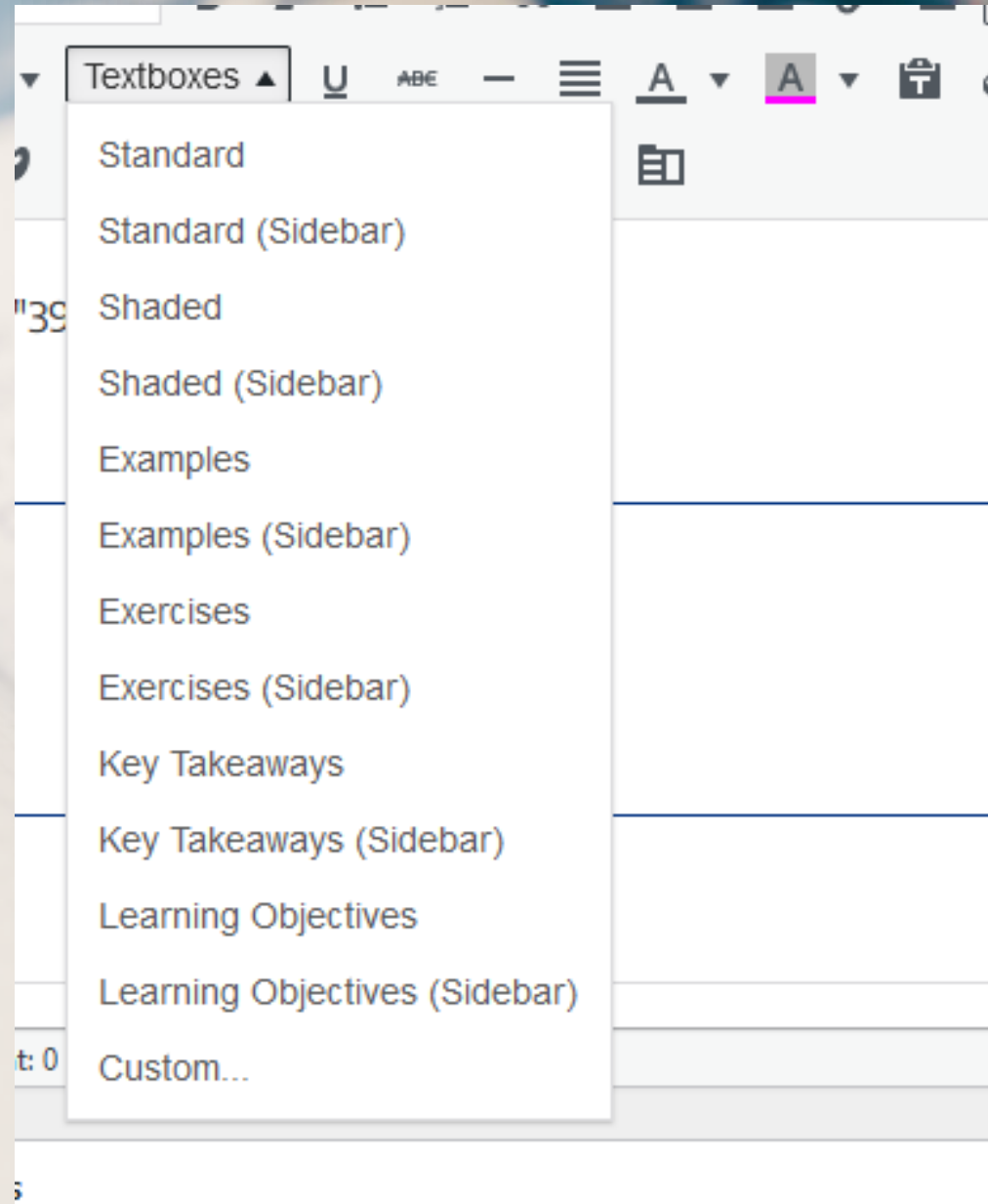
Learning design principles

- Determine learning outcomes first before anything.
- Keep your audience in mind at all times
- Don't stuff the space
- Chunking
- Clear, concise language.
Explain jargon



Learning design principles

- Explicitly state learning outcomes at the start of the book and each chapter.
- Time on task stated.
- Review at end of the chapter.
- Use consistent unifying elements
 - Consistent colour coding (e.g. All examples in boxes of a certain colour)
 - Highlight tips, questions etc. with graphical icons.



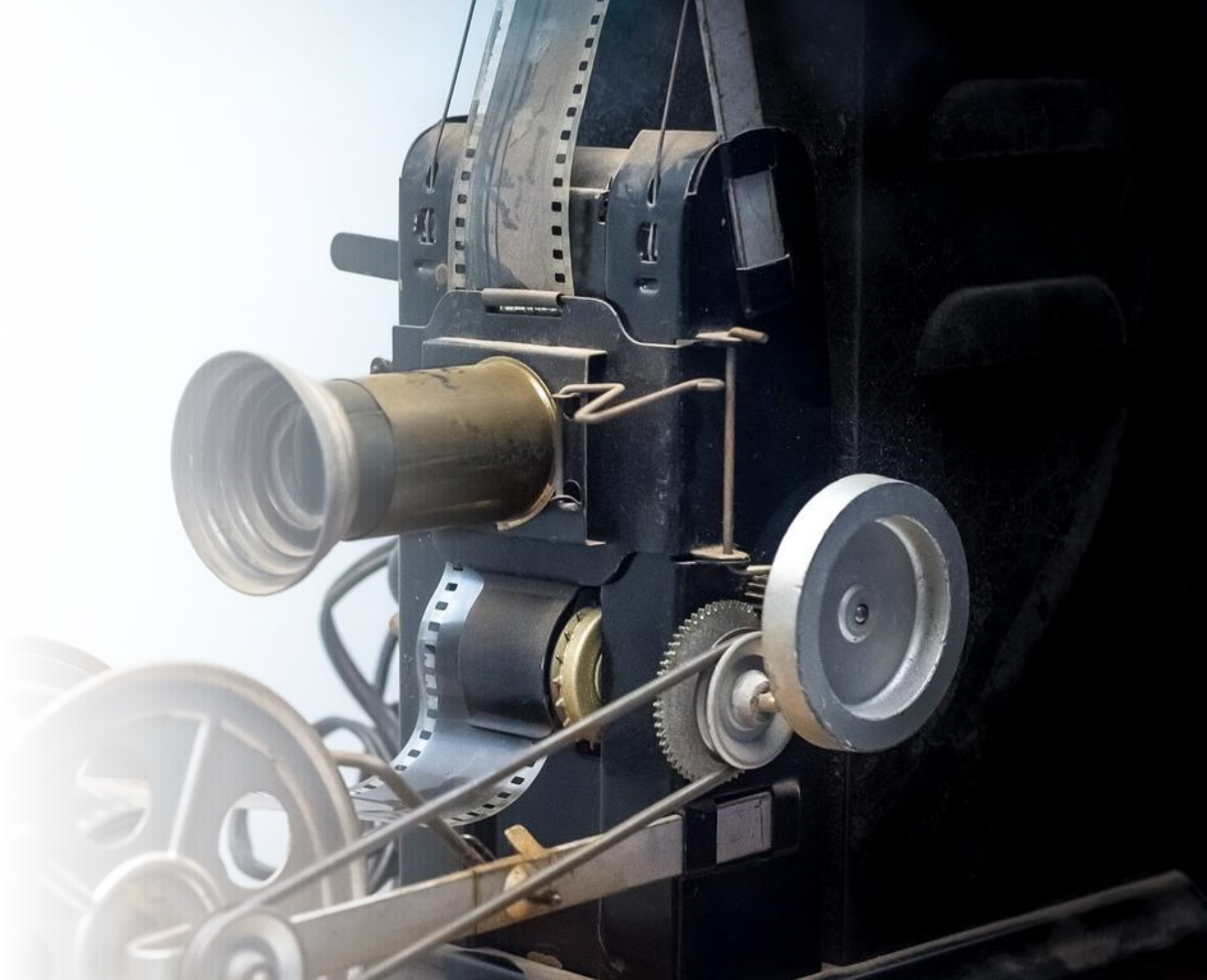
Font and spacing

- 80% students preferred double spaced text.
- Sans serif fonts reduce cognitive load (Hojjati & Muniandy, 2014).
- **Yes:** Arial or Calibri
- **No:** Times New Roman
- **Hell no:** *Comic Sans*



Videos

- Keep them under 5 minutes
- Provide transcripts
- Allow for downloads if possible
- Slow, clear narration



Evaluation

- How do you know if something is effective or working well?
- An often overlooked but essential part of the design process.



Active learning

- Active vs. passive learning
- Intrinsic and extraneous cognitive load can be reduced through interactivity and active learning (Yiin & Chern, 2023).



H5P

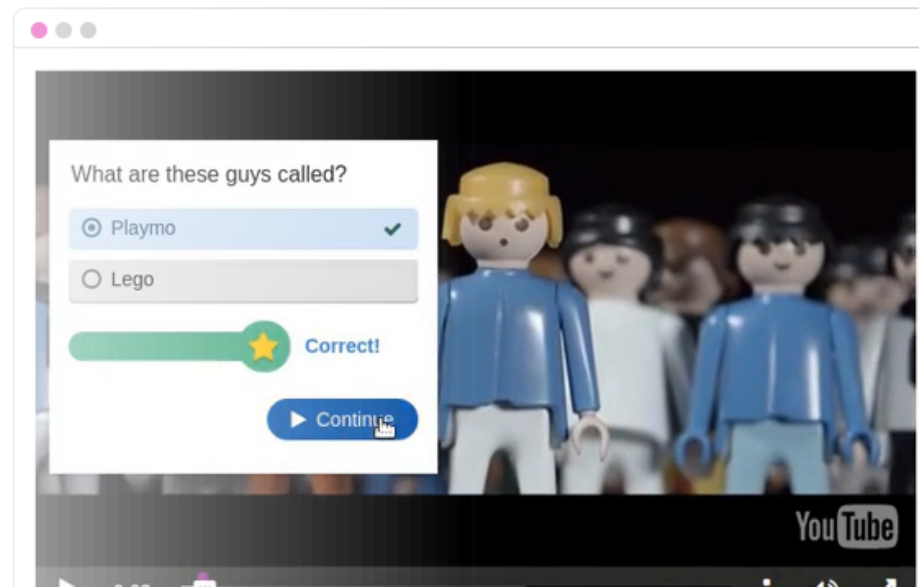
- Suite of tools and activities to increase interactivity and promote active learning.
- Native LMS support (Moodle) or via LTI (Canvas, Blackboard).
- It is not a fix for all your problems!
- Should always be used with a purpose.

> **Do I have to capture results from all databases on the same day?**

✓ **Is there a way to run the same search in all databases at the same time?**


No.

Even if databases are available on the same platform (e.g. Medline and PsycINFO on OVID), it is recommended that you search each database separately. This is because individual databases index publications differently and use different search syntax and subject headings.

Instead, your original search needs to be translated so that it can be interpreted by other databases.

> **Do all databases export to reference management software in the same way?**

> **Can I export all results at the same time?**

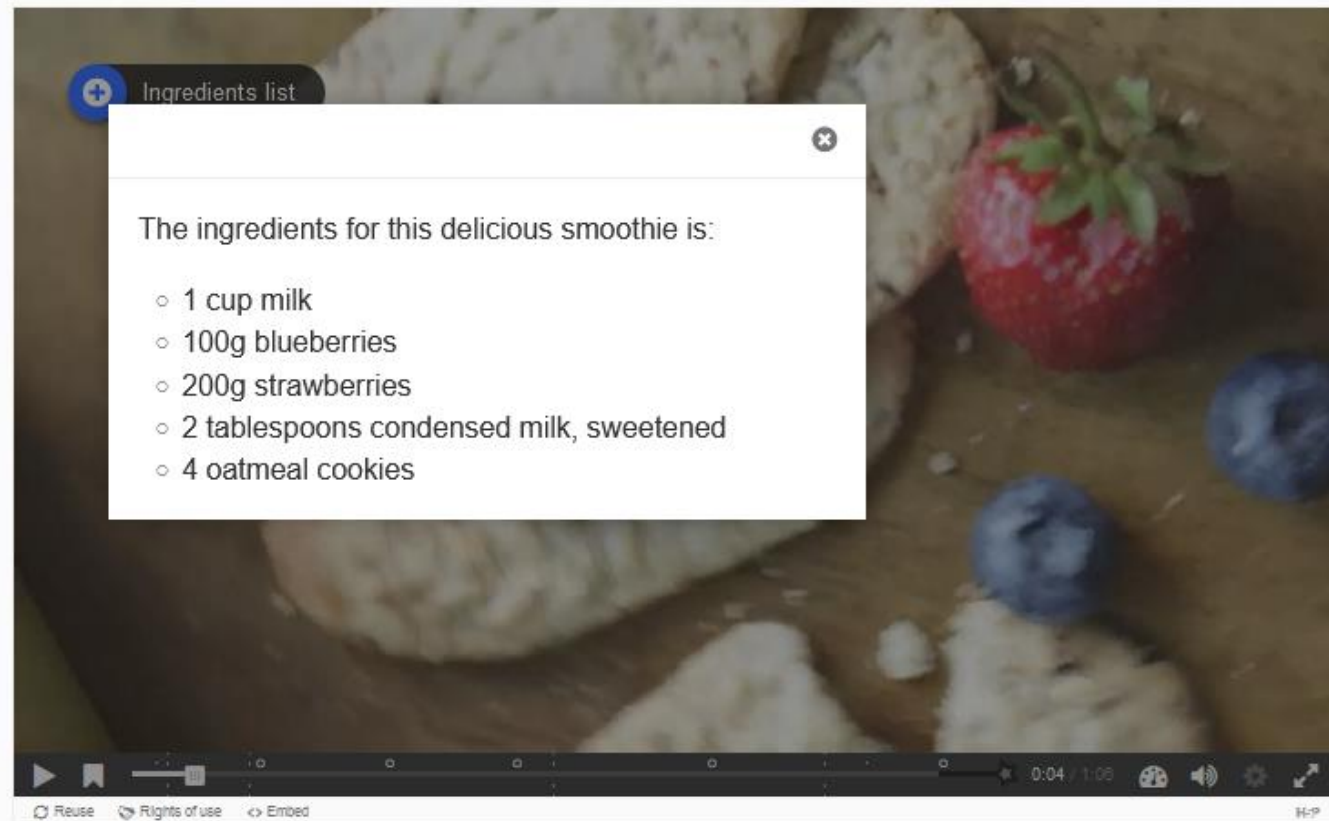

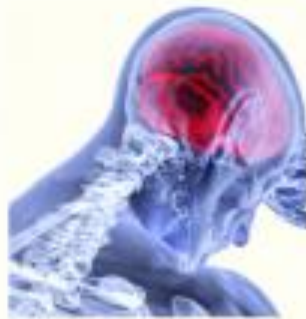
